Frequently Asked Questions

Are Splunk products subject to US Export Controls?

Yes, all Splunk products are subject to US export and re-exports (one foreign country to another foreign country) controls. More specifically, Splunk products, including software, services, and technology are subject to export controls and trade sanctions regulations administered by the United States, including, but not limited to, the U.S. Department of Commerce Bureau of Industry and Security's (BIS) Export Administration Regulations ('EAR'). What is an ECCN number?

Export Control Classification Numbers (ECCNs) are five-character alpha-numeric designations used on the EAR's Commerce Control List (CCL) to identify dual-use items for export control purposes. An ECCN categorizes items based on the nature of the product, i.e., type of commodity, software, or technology and its respective technical parameters.

What is a CCATS number?

Commodity Classification Automated Tracking System (CCATS) is an alphanumeric code issued by the U.S. Department of Commerce's Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) to formal export classification/ECCN reviews it conducts for products under the EAR. This number may be furnished upon request on a product-by-product basis.

What is an Encryption Registration Number (ERN)?

An Encryption Registration Number (ERN) is a number that BIS issued to a company that previously allowed a company to self-classify certain encryption products. However, as of September 20, 2016, ERNs are no longer required, and companies can self-classify certain encryption products and use License Exception ENC without obtaining an ERN so long as a formal classification request is not required under the EAR.
